Limited 8 - Year Warranty (with One Year Full)

COVERTECH INDUSTRIES warrants the purchaser of the winter cover that any defects in material and workmanship will be repaired free of charge or replaced at the company's option within (1) year of purchase of the cover.

2nd year replacement charge - 60% of suggested list price

- 3rd year replacement charge 70% of suggested list price
- 4th year replacement charge 80% of suggested list price
- 5th year replacement charge 85% of suggested list price
- 6th year replacement charge 90% of suggested list price
- 7th year replacement charge 95% of suggested list price

WARRANTY CLAIM REQUIREMENTS

- Cover must be returned to manufacturer customer to pay freight
- Covers returned for repair must be clean and dry. Any cover received dirty will not be repaired.
- Attached to the cover must be an identification tag with the senders complete address and phone number along with proof of purchase.
- You must specify the problem with the cover and the location. If possible provide a sketch.
- Upon receipt, you must allow 8-10 weeks for the repair of the cover.

DO NOT RETURN YOUR COVER TO THE DEALER.

INSTRUCTIONS FOR USE AND INSTALLATION

GENERAL PREPARATIONS

- 1. Since the cover is designed to rest on the pool's water, ensure the pool is not leaking.
- 2. Follow the pool manufacturer's winterizing instructions.
- 3. The pool must be chlorinated until freeze-up to prevent algae growth.
- 4. Pad sharp corners, rough edges or protrusions to protect your new cover.
- 5. Lower the water level in the pool below the skimmer (18" below coping).
- 6. Lay the cover on the ground with the black side down.
- 7. It is important that covers be installed properly and snugly to prevent flopping in high winds which will cause damage to cover.

ABOVE GROUND POOL INSTALLATION

- 1. Thread the cable through the loops until the ends of the cable meet.
- 2. Pull cable as tight as you can using your hands.
- 3. Insert on cable end through the other hole in the winch and into the center spindle. Insert the other cable end through the other hole in the winch and pull both ends of the cable as far as it will go. Turn the winch handle to tighten the cable. Make sure the cable is tight against the pool wall to prevent wind from causing cover to flop.
- 4. For deck pools, cut individual pieces and tie loops to the deck post.

IN-GROUND POOL INSTALLATION

- 1. Secure the cover by placing unfilled water bags on the outside perimeter of the cover.
- 2. The water bags must cover the entire perimeter of the cover.
- 3. Proceed in filling the water bags only half-filled allowing for ice expansion in freezing temperature.
